Request from Miss Aldous

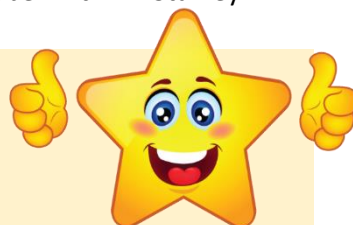

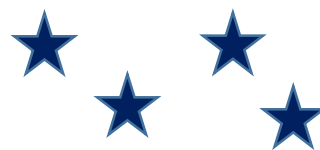
Our School Councillors Ben and Harvey delivered our harvest to Stroud Food Bank at Brimscombe on Friday 25th October with Mr Stanley.
