Preparations are now well underway for this year's Randwick Wap on 9th May. The Wap procession involves a number of adult and child roles and we will be accepting nominations for these roles during February. All children at the school are eligible for nomination. However in order to nominate a child you must have signed the Poll Book (our electoral register) by 31 January. There will be an opportunity for eligible parents and carers to sign the Poll Book on Friday 24th January, immediately after school. The Poll Book may only be signed by those who are resident in the Parish (or who were resident at birth), those owning land in the Parish, or those who (themselves) went to Randwick school or Cashes Green school. If you are not eligible to sign the Poll Book yourself, then we would hope that you are able to find another parent who is eligible to nominate your child. Nomination forms will be distributed at the start of February.
