This week we were joined on Tuesday by our School Improvement Partner, Mr Huw Evans. Huw is employed by us to ensure we are doing all we can to offer the very best education to your children, and has so far been in for a morning to observe teaching, and to talk to children about their learning. On Tuesday he observed maths, reading and writing, met with two of our Governors, our senior and middle leaders and with some of the children. He also heard some children in years 1,2 and 3 read. We await his report but verbal feedback started with - 'you should all be very proud', as indeed we are. We need to continue working on our curriculum and put more information regarding this on the website; we need to look at what books we encourage our free readers to read from school (most likely the reading passport books which we will provide in school).
