### Lost watch

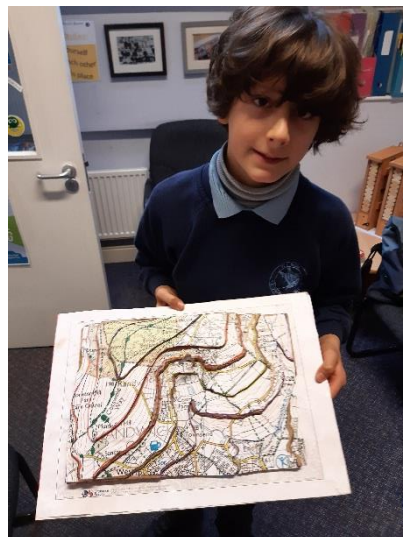
A Spiderman watch has been handed in to school. If it belongs to your child, please contact the office.

Our next meeting is Tues 3<sup>rd</sup> March 8pm at the Vine Tree Pub.

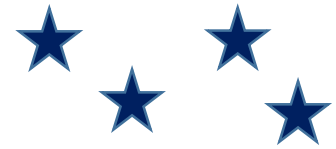
### Easter Disco Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020
