Asthma

All staff had first aid training on Wednesday after school and we were reminded how to use an inhaler. This youtube clip is useful if your child has an inhaler:

Your child will have a space, unlike in this clip, but the important bit is that children inhale slowly, not with one quick deep breath. Spacers make a whistling type noise if children are breathing in too quickly. Do ask any of us if you are not sure. We do have a spare in school for emergencies. Please also let us know if your child has been prescribed an inhaler and make sure we have one in school at all times.
