Arrival and Departure

A gentle reminder to help us preserve our 'bubbles'. Do make sure your child arrives/leaves on time and via the specific doors/playgrounds:

- children of keyworkers to come to school between 08:30 and 08:40 via the back gate
- y6 to come to school between 08:40 and 08:45 via the gate nearest the church (not across the front of school) and to wait on the playground for Mr H
- y1 to arrive between 08:40 and 08:45 via the front gate and from The Lane
- EYFS to arrive between 08:55 and 09:00 via the front gate and from The Lane

I appreciate the complexities involved if you have more than one child in school, and you may need to wait outside the main gate if you have a y6 or y1 child and a sibling in EYFS, or leave your EYFS child with a member of staff, (usually me).
