Buzzard Class Reading Books

Please help us support your child with their reading by making sure their reading books and reading records come to school daily. There are several members of staff who hear the children read over the course of a week. We have invested heavily in Phonics Bug reading books so books match the phonics phase they are working on in school. Our aim is to ensure children are fluent by y3 and able to start the Read Write Inc Spelling programme. Thank you for your support.

Water Bottles

Please remember to send your child to school with a named water bottle every day. Children have access to their water in class during the day.

NHS COVID-19 app.

We have been asked to share this information. The NHS COVID-19 App is part of the large scale coronavirus (COVID-19) testing and contact tracing programme and will be used, alongside traditional contact tracing, to notify users if they come into contact with someone who later tests positive for coronavirus – helping to keep us all safer. The NHS COVID-19 App alerts people at risk of coronavirus, asking them to isolate before they potentially pass the virus on to others as well as providing local area alerts and QR venue check-in. The app will help the NHS understand if the virus is spreading in a particular area, and so local authorities can respond quickly to stop it spreading further and save lives. The app does this while protecting a user's anonymity. Nobody, including the government, will know who or where a particular user is.
