Please do come along to the worship on a Thursday if you are free, it would be lovely to see parents in the audience to celebrate with the children.

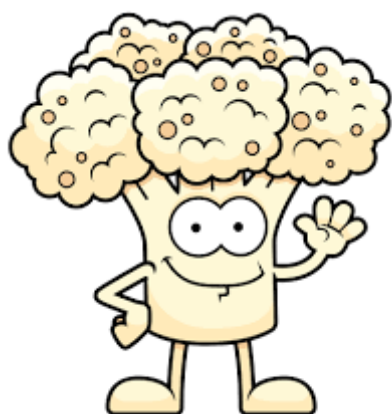
